## **ARC - Wilderness First Aid Training... for Scouts, Scouters, & Outdoorsman**

**May 16th and 17th, 2009 - Location Camp Wisdom**

The American Red Cross *Wilderness First Aid Basics* (WFAB) program is an outdoor oriented first aid training program. This is a 16-hour first aid course for backcountry situations when EMS is not readily available.

The “Wilderness First Aid Basics” program is training designed especially for High Adventure Back Country, and/or When Help Is Delayed situations. Typical students include Venturing Crews, Venture Patrols and older Scouts as well as Scouters supporting an advanced outdoor “high adventure” program; however, any outdoorsman is welcome.

The course includes classroom presentations and skills practice as well as outdoor activities including realistic scenarios and other problem solving opportunities. This program is held as an overnighter at Camp Wisdom – Camping Space available for Friday and Saturday evening. The course fee is \$70.00 per person, which includes, course materials, Saturday lunch and dinner, and Sunday breakfast and lunch. **Registration and fee must be received by May 8th, 2009.**

**NO WALK-INS - Class Starts Saturday at 7:45 AM. Sign in starts @ 7:15 AM**

Those who successfully complete this class will receive a "Wilderness First Aid Basics" card and, a “When Help Is Delayed” card. The class has no prerequisites; however, it is highly recommended that you are current in American Red Cross First Aid and Adult CPR.

Attendance at our class is generally limited to Venture age Scouts 14 and older. All youth participants must have Scoutmaster or Unit Leader's recommendation. Girl Scouts, Venturers, Royal Rangers and other approved youth groups and leaders are very welcome too. This class requires a mature attitude and is physically challenging... and a lot of fun!
